Open Call- deadline 12pm 11th March 2018

Threads, a nomadic Artist-led Gallery, provides opportunities for showcasing and developing artists and their work. Our ethos is to offer paid opportunities, mentoring and professional development to equip artists with a wide range of tools not usually accessible.

Threads has successfully run over 30 critiques across Kent since 2015, allowing this project to cement the potential of peer to peer critiques. Threads have developed a programme of constructive development that bridges the gap between residency and crit.

Threads introduce a unique opportunity to take part in **residencies** and **salons** across East Kent during 2018 including:

This open call is **free to apply** allowing individuals at **any stage of their career** to access a valuable experience, impacting their artistic and professional development. Artists will be given the opportunity to respond to our partners unique locations, towns and communities to engage in Kent's flourishing cultural scene.

Threads will be offering a **4 day residency and 1 day residencies** to meet the need for short duration residencies. The residencies will hold **peer critiques** to aid artistic development. A closed critique, to focus the intention for the day. And an open critique to allow critical discourse between participants and the public. Additional public **salons**, paneled by experienced advisors will further professional development and future progression.

This opportunity offers grounded feedback and communication from directors and advisors from across the region. We want to encourage applications from artists who struggle to find time and space to dedicate to producing new work. Therefore we will be looking to select individuals who express intentions that explore experimentation.

All selected artists will be invited to attend a **Celebration Event** in August at The Sidney Cooper Gallery, following our 4 day residency. Open to the public, this event will bring together influential partners and regional representatives to lead conversational style discussions surrounding the role of contemporary art interaction in East Kent. Providing an exciting opportunity to engage with fellow selected artists and peer networking. We will close this celebration event with performance from sound artists from the region.

Selection Process

Threads will select artists based on ideas, originality and enthusiasm with the help of our board of advisors: Terry Smith (Artist), Kate McGown (Curator, Sidney Cooper Gallery), Clare Smith (Director, Dover Arts Development), Jane Pitt (Producer, Ideas Test)

Allowing the general public access to the space during the residency. Threads will have a closed critique with the selected 5 Artists at the start of the residency. There will be an open critique during the residency to provide the selected artists the opportunity to showcase the work created during the residency alongside a valuable networking opportunity with artists attending the critique who will be sharing theirs own work in progress.

Fee - each artist will be paid a fee of £800.00

The fee is intended to contribute to costs associated with attendance including: travel, accommodation and everyday expenses.

A closed critique with Threads and the selected Artists at the start of the residency. Each artist will be paid a fee of £200.00
